### **Board Reject Swimming Pool Cover Bid Tuesday, Oct. 5, 2004**

- The Granbury Board of Trustees unanimously voted Monday night to reject the bid to cover the Granbury City Pool with an inflatable dome. The bid, which was projected to come in around \$300,000, came in almost \$100,000 over the original projections. "If we were going to be able to use the pool for this swim season, I might be more apt to approve this," Board vice president Jerry Campbell said. "It's not going to hurt us to reject this bid and start over."
- Along the same front, the Board voted to appoint superintendent William Harris as a representative to a swimming pool feasibility committee made up of representatives from Hood County, the City of Granbury, the Hood County Hospital District and Granbury ISD. "I'm very excited about this," Board president Charlie Cloud said. "This is a way for all of us to work together to help not only our students, but the community as well."
- A budget amendment for GEA Channel 7 equipment purchase was discussed and then passed in a 7-0 vote.
- Approved consent agenda items minutes of the Sept. 13, 2004 meeting; maximum travel reimbursement rates for 2004-05; flooring materials and services bid no. 2003-06-renewal; and Title I Part A waiver for Oak Woods Intermediate.
- Lorrie Wallace (Acton Elementary), Lora Jane Green (Crossland Intermediate) and Jason Worthen (Granbury High School) were hired.
- Acton Middle School ninth-grader Mariana Pages was honored for being a semifinalist in the Discover Channel Young Scientist Challenge
- The Masonic Lodge honored Granbury High School associate principal Marsha Grissom with the Community Builders Award. Grissom was presented a plaque and a meritorious award for her desk. Grissom's husband, retired GISD counselor Don Grissom as well as several members of the GHS faculty were on hand to honor Grissom.

- The Board nominated Gary Raper and Michael Carmichael as candidates for the Hood County Appraisal District Board of Directors.
- Approved drainage channel modifications by the City of Granbury at Granbury Middle School.
- Approved The Board will meet again on Monday, Oct. 18.
