National, state record broken in 5A prelims

AUSTIN - San Antonio Churchill junior Annie Chandler broke national and state records in the 100-yard breast stroke Friday in the preliminary round of the Class 5A University Interscholastic League swimming and diving championships.

Chandler recorded a time of one minute, 00.72 seconds, breaking the national mark of 1:00.74, set by Kristen Woodring of West Lawn Wilson, Pa., in 1996.

Dana Vollmer of Granbury also set a state record in the 200 freestyle at 1:49.69. Vollmer's time in the 100-yard butterfly missed a state record by two-hundredths of a second.

The top eight finishers in each event advance to Saturday's finals.
